Scientific and Useful.

PREPARING APPLE SAUCE.—Slice and core the apples without paring them. The sauce is of the finest flavour.

It soothes and cools a feverish patient to bathe him with warm water in which a little saleratus has been dissolved.

INK stains on a tablecloth may be removed if milk is applied the moment the ink is spilt and the spot afterward washed.

DELICATE CAKE.—Three cupfuls flour, two of sugar, three-fourths cupful sweet milk, whites of six eggs, half cup of butter, tea spoonful cream of tartar, one-fourth tea spoonful soda. Flavour with lemon. Good and easily made.

PEACH PIE.—Line a deep dish with soda biscuit dough or pie crust rolled one-fourth of an inch thick, filled with peaches pared, sprinkle with sugar and a little flour, and if not too juicy add about two table spoonfuls of water, put on the upper crust, secure the edges and bake. Eat with cream.

CAKE.—Beat the yolks of eight eggs thoroughly, add one pint of sugar little by little, and the grated rind of one lemon; beat the whites of the eggs to a stiff froth, and add them alternately with three gills of flour, beating very gently and barely long enough to mix well. When part of the flour is in, add the lemon juice. Bake twenty minutes in small loaves.

VINEGAR FOR PICKLING.—Put two pounds of coarsest brown sugar to one gallon of cold fresh water, mix well, then put a little yeast on to a piece of toast, and lay on the liquid; stir well for a week, then cover the vessel with brown paper, in which holes have been made with a pin, keep in a warm place, and in about four months time you will have good strong vinegar.

TO SELECT RIPE WATERMELONS.—When the melon begins to change colour inside, and its seeds turn black, a small speck, scale or blister begins to appear on the outer circle or rind. These are multiplied and enlarged as the fruit matures. A ripe melon will show them thickly over the surface. A partial development only indicates half-ripened fruit. A full crop of blisters reveals its perfect ripeness.

MARKS ON THE WALL.—Housekeepers are frequently annoyed by oil marks on papered walls against which thoughtless persons have laid their heads. These unsightly marks may be removed by making a paste of cold water and pipe clay or fuller's earth, and laying it on the surface without rubbing it on, else the pattern of the paper will then likely be injured. Leave the paste on all night. In the morning it can be brushed off and the spots will have disappeared, but a renewal of the operation may be necessary if the oil mark is old. The experiment will be likely to result most satisfactorily on plain papers, or that with the least number of coloured figures.

A GOOD MEAL.—Charles Dickens used to say that he judged the quality of house-keeping by the condition of the castors on the table. If the mustard was freshly made, the vinegar cruet stainless, the silver brilliant, and the pepper-boxes perpendicular, he expected a good, clean, well-served meal, "with behaviour to match." If, on the contrary, the castors were uncleared, and out of order, he knew what he had to expect, and was seldom disappointed. It is, in truth, simple things that denote quality. The test of a good cook is not the cake she can make, nor the mysterious sauces she can concoct, nor the rich puddings she can produce. A good cook is known by her boiled potatoes, her mutton chop, her roasted joint. Such plain things require personal care and judgment, and are the basis of a "good meal."
