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CANADA'S COMMERCE.

A LARGE INCREASE IN THE EXPORTS DURING THE LAST MONTH THE RETURNS ANALYZED.

OTTAWA, Nov. 26.—The following is a statement of the value of the exports from the Dominion of Canada during the month of October last:

Total... \$10,480,610 \$29,587,217. This gives a grand total of \$11,472,227, being an increase of \$944,910 over the same month last year.

Taking the first four months of the fiscal year the total exports of goods the produce of Canada is \$35,163,166, against \$34,720,146 for the same period last year, showing an increase of \$443,020.

The statement for the goods entered for consumption in October is: Coal and lignite... \$8,090,913. Cotton goods... 22,343.
