

To prevent the corrolling or "pitting" of propellor shafts by chemical action with the sea water, brass castings or liners, asually of a thickness of three-eighths to one-half inch, are shunk on in lengths. The objections to these have been their liability to burst and for the joints of the grations length; to give been their liability to burst and for the joints of the various length; to give way. A Sheffield man has now come forward with an invention, by means of which copper, or an alloy of copper, is electrolytically deposited upon the shafts instead of employing the lining or casings. A suitable thickness of copper or alloy has been found to be about one-sixteenth of an inch. By this means all danger of the linings giving way is avoided, while a great saving of weight is effected, and at the same time the electro-chemical action is entirely obviated.
