The P.A.D.A.C. Art Foundation sponsored the participation of 6 art galleries (5 from Ontario: Carmen Lamanna, Olga Korper, S.L. Simpson, Ydessa and Wynick Tuck) at the Cologne Art Fair, November 13-19, 1986. Over 50 artists were represented. Canadian participation was very successful. Galleries were invited to return. The artists sold many works and booked dates for future exhibitions in Germany. Canadian Galleries and artists received extensive, positive press coverage.

P.A.D.A.C. founded in 1966, is the national umbrella organization representing commercial galleries across Canada. The P.A.D.A.C. Art Foundation was established in 1986.
