provide compensation for certain petroleum costs and to regulate the price of Canadian Crude oil and natural gas in interprovincial and export trade and further progress having been made and reported, the Committee obtained leave to consider it again at the next sitting of the House.

By unanimous consent, on motion of Mr. Sharp, it was ordered,—That, notwithstanding the provisions of Standing Order 74(3), when Bill C-58, An Act to amend the Income Tax Act, is read a second time, it shall be referred to the Standing Committee on Broadcasting, Films and Assistance to the Arts.
