For every gallon of Molasses and Syrups which shall be imported or brought into the Province, in any other ships or vessels, in which the same may be legally imported	—	0 0 6

## 3d George 4, Cap. 44.

The articles enumerated below may be imported in *British built Ships only* from any foreign port in Europe, or Africa, Gibraltar, Guernsey, Jersey, Alderney and Sark on paying the following Duties.

If the Colonial Duties are equal in amount to such Duties, in such case the Duties imposed by this Act shall not be levied; if the Colonial Duties are less, the *difference only* between such Colonial Duties and the Duties levied under the authority of this Act shall be payable.

A SCHEDULE of DUTIES payable on Articles imported into His Majesty's Colonies, Plantations or Islands in America or the West Indies from Ports in Europe or Africa, under the authority of this Act.
