THE SENATE OF CANADA

BILL SD-10.

An Act for the relief of Florida McIntyre Marcil.

Preamble.

WHEREAS Florida McIntyre Marcil, residing at the city of Montreal, in the province of Quebec, wife of Georges Marcil, who is domiciled in Canada and residing at Varennes, in the said province, has by her petition alleged that they were married on the eighteenth day of November, 5 A.D. 1942, at the town of Chatham, in the province of New Brunswick, she then being Florida McIntyre; and whereas by her petition she has prayed that, on the ground of his adultery since then, their marriage be dissolved; and whereas the said marriage and adultery have been 10 proved by evidence adduced and it is expedient that the prayer of her petition be granted: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

Marriage dissolved. 1. The said marriage is hereby dissolved, and shall be 15 henceforth null and void to all intents and purposes what-soever.
