FINE LIST ENTRIES FOR KING'S PLATE

Indication That Home-Bred Events at Woodbine Will Be Well Contested.

That the home-bred event will be far better contested this year than any previous year is quite evident by the long list of entries. Twenty-nine are scheduled to go to the post in the King's Plate. Of this number six never before have been seen in public, and thus their merits are unknown. They are: Johnnie Austin, Miss Kapanga, Red Fire, Banjo, Beverly, and Orlatory. Of the remainder, the number, no fewer than ten were winners as two-year-olds. They are: Lady Curson, who will, having missed, go to the post favorite; Pepper Sauce, Osmium, Otero, Spittler, Last Spark, John Peel, Hampton Dams, Maiden Bradley, and Smithfield. The Seagram stable has the largest entry and has a strong chance to pick from it. Charles Miller has three to carry his colors, while Harry Bassett II, who is still in the maiden class, will also carry the Gladstone colors. In addition to Otero, there are 88 entries in the Breeders' Stakes and 17 in the Maple Leaf Stakes, the entries of which will be published next Monday.

The following are the weights and conditions for the King's Plate: The King's Plate—50 guineas, the gift of His Majesty King George V, with \$5000 added by the club. The first horse to receive the guineas, stakes and \$2500; the second horse \$700; and the third horse \$300. The breeder of the winner to receive \$500. A sweepstake of \$5 payable at time of entry, \$5 additional unless declared out by May 1, and \$25 additional for starters. For three-year-olds and upward, the property of a British subject resident in Ontario, foaled, raised and trained in Ontario, that has never won a race, either on the flat or across country, other than a race exclusively for two-year-olds, have never left Canada, and

have never been for a period of more than one month out of this province. Winners to carry 5 lbs. extra. One mile and a quarter. A piece of plate will be presented by the club to the winner.
