There is no School on Saturdays. Boarders are only allowed to go down town on Saturday mornings from 10:45 to 12:15 p.m., when roll is called by the Prefect on duty. During the remainder of the day they are in charge of the Master on duty, unless they are allowed out on leave by special invitation.

The School is divided into two departments, known as the Upper and Lower School.

UPPER SCHOOL

The ordinary School Course is:

English and Canadian History, Geography, Grammar.

Divinity, Bible History.

Practical Ethics in the case of non-Christian boys. Latin.

French.

Algebra, Euclid, Arithmetic, Trigonometry. Greek (at option of parent or guardian).

LOWER SCOOOL

The ordinary Course is:

Reading, Writing, Spelling.

Elementary English and Canadian Geography.

English and Canadian History Outlines.

Bible History.

Latin up to the end of the Regular Verbs, and including a knowledge of Simple Construction.

French up to the end of the Regular Verbs, and including a knowledge of Simple Construction.

Arithmetic up to and including Fractions

Parents are strongly recommended to allow their boys to pursue the study of Latin and French, as a matter of mental discipline even when not looking forward to University work.
