without a parallel in history. All over Canada meetings were held; the one at London was large and influential. I was called to preside, and never could there be more pathos and honest sympathy thrown into eloquent speeches and warm resolutions than on that occasion. So shortly before, having seen and conversed with Mr. Lincoln, my feelings were greatly aroused. The resolutions were promptly forwarded to Washington.

Mr. Lincoln, owing to the important events of his life and the tragedy of his death, will ever be revered and honored equal to Washington, the Father of his Country.
