
Tariffs Relating to Cabs, Livery Carriages, Etc.

. Every cabman on each occasion when his cab is hired shall, when demanded of him, hand this card to the person employing him.

No fare is to be paid to any cabman who refuses to hand this card to the person employing him or who demands a greater rate than allowed by the following tariff.



One or Two-horse Cabs.

First Division.	
SERVICE.	FARE.
One or two persons	50 cents.
Each additional person	25 cents.
SECOND DIVISION.	
One or two persons	75 cents.
	25 cents.
Third Division.	
One or two persons	\$1.00.
Each additional person	a5 cents.

The fare by the hour for one or four persons in a two-horse cab is \$1.25, and for each subsequent hour, \$1.00. Each additional person 25 cents.

The fare by the hour for one or three persons in a single horse cab is \$1.00, and for each subsequent hour, 75 cents.

Night Tariff.

The charges for cabs after 12 o'clock midnight to 6 a.m. shall be one-half more than the aforesaid tariff.
