That from and after the publication hereof no person or persons keeping caleshes, carrioles, or other carriages for hire, within the town or fuburbs of Quebec, shall ask or receive more than seven shillings and fix pence currency, for carrying one or two persons with their baggage to the Post-house at Lorrette, or for the use of their calesh or carriole with a horse and man to drive the same for the space of one day, to go to any place not exceeding four leagues from Quebec, the sum of ten shillings and no more: and it is ordered that all and every person whatsoever shall have one or more horse-bells affixed to the collar of each horse, which he or she shall cause to be tackled to any train, fled or carriole which he or she shall drive or cause to be driven in the city or environs of Quebec, fo long as the fnow shall remain on the ground. And all carters and every other person letting horses and carriages to persons, riding Post, shall carry their fare to the first stage at Lorrette under the penalty of twenty shillings.
