

The Lieutenant-Governor of the Province of Ontario, for the time being, shall be respectfully requested to become "Patron."

6. There shall be a President.

7. There shall be four Vice-Presidents, one for each Military District.

8. There shall be a Council, composed as follows :—

1st. Four members from each of the Military Districts, who shall be elected primarily at this meeting, and hereafter at the annual meeting.

2nd. The Brigade Majors.

3rd. The Presidents of local affiliated Associations and Clubs, being members of the Association—

Five of whom shall form a quorum ; and in the event of vacancies occurring in the elective members from any cause whatever, the remaining members of the Council shall have the power of filling such vacancies.

9. The Council shall choose from the members elected the President of the Association.

10. There shall be a Vice-President for each Military District, selected from among the members of the Council for such District, and who shall be elected by the Council.

11. There shall be a Treasurer, and there shall be a Secretary at Toronto, both to be appointed by the Council, and holding office during pleasure.

12. The Council shall have the sole management of the income and funds of the Association, rendering an account to the yearly meeting—such account having been previously audited by a person or persons not
