regarder, v. a., look at; concern; *qu ne me regarde pas*, that is not my business, I have nothing to do with that.
registre, n. m., register, travellers' or visitors' book.
regret, n. m., regret.
regretter, v. a., regret, be sorry for.
rein, n. m., kidney (in plur., the loins, small of back); *les reins*! my back!
reine, n. f., queen.
réitérer, v. a., reiterate, repeat.
rejoindre, v. ir. a., join again; overtake; *je vous rejoins*, I shall join you presently.
relire, v. ir. a., read again, re-read.
reissant, vide *relire*.
remarquer, v. a., remark, notice.
rembourser, v. a., pay back.
remercier, v. a., thank (for=*de*).
remerciement, n. m. (usually plur.), act of thanking, thanks.
remet, **remettra**, vide *remettre*.
remettre, v. ir. a., put back; hand, hand over, deliver (up); revive, bring round; *se remettre*, recover, be all right again.
remis, vide *remettre*.
remonter, v. n., go (come) up again; go up the stage (i.e., towards the rear), go away.
remorqueur, n. m., towing-boat, steam-tug.
remplacer, v. a., replace, take instead.
rencontre, n. f., (accidental) meeting.
rencontrer, v. a., fall in with; *se rencontrer avec*, meet.
rendez-vous, n. m. (imperative of *se rendre*), rendezvous, appointment; *donner rendez-vous à qqn.*, to make an appointment to meet one.
rendre, v. a., give back, return, restore; render; do; *rendre réponse*, give some answer.
renfermer, v. a., shut in; *se renfermer*, shut oneself up, restrict (confine) oneself.
renseignement, n. m., information; *prendre des renseignements*, make enquiries.
rente, n. f., income, revenue.
rentier, n. m., one who lives on his income, gentleman, often=retired merchant, etc.
rentrer, v. n., go (come) in again; go (come) back into; come (go) back (home).
renverser, v. a., overturn.
renvoyer, v. ir. a., send away, send off.
repars, vide *repartir*.
repartir, v. ir. n., set off (out) again.
repas, n. m., repast, meal.
repasser, v. n., call again.
repêcher, v. a., fish up again, pull out.
