

RAILWAYMEN FINED.

**Violations of Anti-Rebate Law
Heavily Punished in Chicago.**

Chicago, April 20.—The Chicago, Burlington and Quincy Railway and Darus Miller and Claude G. Burnham, officials of the road, were found guilty in the federal court to-day of granting rebates in violation of law. The railroad corporation was fined \$40,000 and the two officials \$10,000 each.
