A.28	It was our intentions to go to Edmonton for a couple of days and then come back.
Q.29	Just for a couple of days' holiday from the Army, eh? And after you were in Edmonton for a couple of days, then what happened?
A.29	Then Line didn't want to come back. He said we were gone now and we might as well stay until before 21 days were up.
Q.30	You knew that after 21 days you would be classed as a deserter?
A.30	Yes, sir.
Q.31	You intended to return before that time?
A.31	Yes, sir.
Q.32	Then what happened?
A.32	We went West to Edson and stayed there.
9.33	What reasons had you for going to Edson and why did you stay there?
A.33	No reasons at all, sir.
Q.34	Just roaming?
A.34	Yes, eir.
Q.35	At Edson, what happened?
A.35	We ran out of money so applied for work at a logging camp. We figured as soon as we had the money we would go back to Red Deer.
Q.36	At this first camp that you went to, you applied for work in uniforms?
A.36	Yes, sir.
Q.37	Didn't your prospective employer think that peculiar?
A.37	Yes. He told us he couldn't hire soldiers and we tol him we were on furlough, so he hired us then.
Q.38	How long did you work for him?
A.38	For about a week,
Q.59	So you worked for him for about a week wearing your uniforms?
A.39	Yes, sir.
