

"HELL DOWN THERE," SAYS ENGINEER OF FIRE ZONE

Forest Fires Still Raging in Northern Minnesota and Will Only Die Out from Lack of Material -- Death List Placed at 100 -- Tales of Horror and Suffering.

Warroad, Minn., Oct. 10.—Latest reports of the forest fires in the Rainy River region in Minnesota increase the horrors of the situation, if not the number of lives lost. The estimated number of persons killed range from 75 to 400. Several conservative men of business and authority, place the deaths at more than 100. But the greater concern for the present is the rescue of the helpless and the relief of thousands of homeless men, women and children.


MISSISSQUASH MARSH CANAL


COL. GOETTING AGAIN.
