OPTIMISTIC VIEW OF FUTURE OF PROVINCE

Continued from Page 1.
ports of the Dominion, and therefore
has exceptional facilities for com-
merce and shipping. It is well supplied
with railways and although its roads
are not as many as in the United States
they are nevertheless extensive and
on the whole satisfactory. The prov-
ince possesses a large and healthy pop-
ulation to the extent of 150,000 H. P., which
should be a great incentive to man-
ufacturers. You have also a seemingly
unlimited supply of natural gas which
if, and when, put to proper commercial
use should result in great industrial
developments in the district. The
province, despite what has been said, is ap-
parently rich in minerals, and the
large deposits of coal and iron ore are
likely of themselves to lead to con-
siderable industrial growth.

"These, sir, are but a few of the
treasures which Providence has so
bountifully showered upon this prov-
ince, and I venture to think that im-
mediate and energetic steps should be
taken to place before the people of
Great Britain and if you like other
Northern European peoples, the true
state of affairs here.
