



This is voiced today by the Petit Journal, which in treating of the financial aspects of the situ-ation also states that it appears France will be completely indemnified The belief prevails, the newspaper adds, that Premier Clemenceau's viewpoint regarding reclamations from Germany and a special indemnity for pensions for cripples and war widows will be upheld.
