

MATRICULATION.

Candidates for Matriculation must be able to pass an examination in the following subjects, viz:—

Geography [Ancient and Modern.]

Arithmetic.

English Grammar and Composition Bullion & Quackenbos.

Outlines of English History.

Latin Grammar Andrews.

Cornelius Nepos.

Sallust, de Conjuratione Catilinæ.

Arnold's First Book in Latin.

Greek Grammar, and Greek Reader......Bullion.

After Matriculation the Course of Study embraces four years as prescribed below, on the satisfactory completion of which, students are admitted to the degree of Bachelor of Arts.

Candidates may be admitted to advanced standing in the Course, by passing an examination in all the studies preceding the year in which they propose to enter.

No one, however, will be allowed to enter later than at the beginning of the Senior Year.

Any student not intending to graduate, may pursue a special or elective course, selecting such studies as his circumstances may allow, and omitting the others.
