AN ACT

TO INCORPORATE THE

HALIFAX CO-OPERATIVE SOCIETY.

Passed 7th May, 1866.

Be it enacted by the Governor, Council, and Assembly, as follows:—

- 1. The following persons, that is to say, James Martin, Michael O'Brien, Robt. Jas. Wilson, John Heenan, Michael J. Clinton, William Williams, Jas. Gwatkin, Jas. Griffin, Edward Flanigan, Jas. Reardon, George W. Jackson, and all such other persons as now are or shall hereafter become members of this Society, and their successors, shall be a body corporate, by the name of the Halifax Co-operative Society.
- 2. The objects of the Society shall be the improvement and promotion of the welfare of the working classes of the city of Halifax and vicinity, by providing a safe and profitable investment for the small savings of the working man, in such manner as is set forth in the rules of the Society.
- 3. The Society shall not, at any time, hold real estate of greater value than forty thousand dollars.
