Dublin.

On the 15th of April, Mr. Wm. O'Brien, M. P., was presented with the handsomely illuminated address that had been prepared for him by the Nationalist students of Dublin, but only the original manuscript copy of which had been handed to him on coming out of Tullamore jail.

Popular opinion in Dublin directly sets down the second arrest of Mr. O'Brien to an intent on the part of Mr. Balfour to dwarf the significance of the New Ross meeting.

The following pastoral notice from the Most Rev. Dr. Nulty was read in all the churches of his diocese on Sunday, April 15th: "We announce, to day, that the Bishop, after mature deliberation, has come to the conclusion that the tons of the Examiners is such a renders reading of it dangerous to members of his flock."

HOLY COMMUNION—THE MOST LOVING, AT THE SAME TIME THE MOST DEAR, INVENTION OF DIVINE LOVE.

DEAR PEOPLE: For the last few days we have been speaking of the Eucharist from a purely doctrinal point of view. Now that we are nearing the Sunday, the last day for completing the paschal precept, it would honor us to speak on the obligation of obeying the Fourth Commandment of the Church: To receive Communion at least once a year.

A man thirsting for glory and distinction could conceive no higher honor than this. Suppose that in the days of Old Dispensation God had chosen Abraham or David, or any of the Patriarchs, and asked them what honor they would confer upon the human race in sign of His love. I have no hesitation in saying that not one of them could have imagined the honor reserved for our human nature in the mystery of the Last Supper.

It is with Holy Communion; we pass over mystery upon mystery, we realize the height and depth of love that has been incarnated in the crib at Bethlehem, the poverty of Nazareth, the scourging and the crown of thorns, the crucifixion itself, were preparatory mysteries. To be witness day and night in our tabernacles, a few feet of us, blessing our families, our homes, receiving our petitions, sending our sweet messages from the tabernacle, is a mystery of infinity of His love which eternally is not long enough to praise Him; but even this perpetual presence in the masterpiece or consummation of His love, is not all that He has in store for us. To unite with Him in the heart and soul; to mingle our blood with ours, His soul with ours, His life with our life; to become our brethren, our nourishment; to lovingly invite us to press us, to take us by the hand, to lead us to this banquet of His own blood. This is love's last term; divine can go no farther. "Oh, Pious Heart," says St. Thomas Aquinas, adding our Saviour in one of those beautiful hymns of his, written in honor of the Blessed Sacrament.

In ecclesiastical heraldry, borne on the banner of the Holy Eucharist, the pelican is represented wounding its breast to feed its weak and feeble young with its own flesh and blood. Trinity Sunday, the last Sunday of the month, will be the last day for completing the paschal precept. May the permitted hope of our redemption and paths of this happy apostrophe of the Angelic Doctor will produce you the same effect as a rigid expiation of the Fourth Commandment of the Church, Thy God thou shalt receive.
