Their Powers. and to lend di kruz Wiecepts, under their hands and Seals, to all rion of Perions whatfoever, and for fush Books, Popers, Writings, or Records, as they thall judge necessary for their Information in the Erecution of the Powers velled in the said Commissioners by this Ad; and the faid Commissioners, or any Three or more of them, are hereby authorised to appoint and employ such Clerks, Wellengers, and Officers, as they thall think meet; which Clerks and Officers are hereby required faithfully to crecute and perform the Trust in them scherally and respectively reposed, without taking any Thing for such their Service, other than such Salary of Rewards as the laid Commissioners, of any Three or more of them, thall think fit to direct and appoint in that Behalf.

Persons who deliver in fraudulent Claims, to be excluded from any Compenfation.

V. And he it enasted by the Authority aforesaid. That if it thall appear to the faid Commissioners that any Person wall have delivered to them an Account or Claim beyond the real Loss, with an Intent to obtain moze than a just Compensation, the said Commissioners shall, with all convenient Dispatch, report such Account or Claim. with the Evidence taken thereupon, to the Commissioners of his Hajelly's Treasury, who are hereby authorised to make such further Enquiry upon the Case as they Hall think proper; and if they, or any Three of them, hall be of Opinion that such Account or Claim is fraudulent. then such Person shall be absolutely excluded from any Compensation of Provision whatsoever.

Perfons wilfully giving false Evidence, to be liable to the Penalties of corrupt Perjury.

VI. And be it further enacted by the Authority aforefaid, That in case any Person of Persons, upon Examination upon Dath before the faid Commissioners respectively, as before mentioned, thall wilfully and comuntly give false Evidence, every such Person so offending, and being thereof duly convided, hall be, and is and are hereby declared to be subject and liable to such Pains and Penalties as, by any Law now in being, Persons convided of wilful and coxupt Perjury are subject and liable to.

VII. And be it further enacted, That no Claim or Request of any Person of Persons for Aid of Relief on Account
