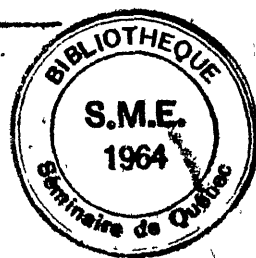


IN THE FOURTEENTH YEAR OF THE REIGN OF
