and \$20 for those studying to pass as masters; and students, after having matriculated, have the right to attend the school free for any length of time, until they have obtained their certificates from the Dominion Board of Examiners.

Should extra examinations be established before the Dominion Board of Examiners, the preparation for those extra examinations of such candidates as will have made their studies at this school will be free of any charge.

The tutor of the school makes a monthly report to the Provincial Secretary, stating the number and proficiency of students, and the number of candidates from the school who have successfully passed the Dominion Board of Examiners for certificates of masters and mates.

Persons desirous of entering the school may apply to the Honourable the Provincial Secretary, or to Wm. C. Seaton, Esquire-at Ouebec.
