Form and size
of Printed

XVII. That in future, the Journals and Appendices as also Sessional Papers (Bills excepted,) be printed in Royal Octavo form, of the size of the Report on Trade and Navigation for 1851, with new small pica type, without marginal notes, and with but two blank lines between the page heading and reading matter. The Yeas and Nays in the Journals to be in long primer, in four columns.

XVII. That no Bill be introduced into the House, either in blank or only in part completed.
