

BILL.

An Act to repeal the laws relating to
Winter Roads in Lower Canada.

WHEREAS experience hath shewn the Preamble.
inefficacy and impracticability of the
ordinances relating to winter roads, which
enact that no cariole, sleigh, berline or other
5 winter vehicle, other than the sleighs or
trainaux designated in the said ordinances,
shall be used on the Queen's highways or
public roads in Lower Canada:—Be it there-
fore enacted, &c.

10 And it is hereby enacted by the authority
of the same, That from and after the passing
of this Act, the Ordinance of the Legislature
of the late Province of Lower Canada, passed
in the Session held in the third and fourth
15 years of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled:

*"An Ordinance to provide for the improve-
ment, during the winter season, of the Queen's
Highways in this Province, and for other
purposes,"*—and the Ordinance of the said
