## BILL.

An Act to amend the Act respecting the Legislative Council.

WHEREAS it is no longer expedient that the choice of electors of Preamble. Legislative Councillors in each Electoral Division should be restricted to persons residing, or having the requisite property qualification, within the limits thereof: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the ad-5 vice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows :---

C., cap. 10 and vote as a Legislative Councillor, unless his residence, or the lands and tenements, to the value of Eight "housand Dollars, which constitute his property qualification, are within the limits of the Electoral Division for which he seeks to be or has been elected, is hereby repealed.

2. The form in Schedule C, to the said Act, is hereby amended by Schedule C. 15 leaving out all the words from "in," where it occurs the first time in to c.S. C, the third line of the said form, to "that" in the fourth line thereof, ded: and inserting "Canada."
