
BILL

To repeal a certain Act or Ordinance therein mentioned, and to provide more effectual Regulations concerning the practice of Physic, Surgery, and Midwifery in this Province.

WHEREAS it is expedient to repeal an Act or Ordinance passed in the twenty-eighth year of the Reign of His Majesty George the Third, intituled, "An Act or Ordinance to prevent persons practising Physic and Surgery within the Province of Quebec, or Midwifery in the Towns of Quebec and Montreal, without License;" and to provide more effectual regulations with respect to persons practising Physic and Surgery in this Province, as well as Midwifery, and to regulate Druggists and others vending or distributing Medicines by retail;— Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Lower-Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great-Britain, intituled, "An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act passed in the fourteenth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, "An Act for making more effectual provision for the Government of the Province of Quebec in North America;" and to make further provision for the Government of the said Province;" and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, that the said Act or Ordinance passed in the twenty-eighth year of the Reign of His Majesty George the Third, intituled, "An Act or Ordinance to prevent persons practising Physic and Surgery within the Province of Quebec, or Midwifery in the Towns of Quebec and Montreal, without License," shall be, and the same is hereby repealed.

II. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that no person shall hereafter, under the penalty hereinafter-mentioned in case of disobedience hereto, practise, for gain or profit, as a Physician or Surgeon in this Province, unless he shall have obtained a License or Commission to that effect, or be otherwise authorised thereunto pursuant to this Act.

III. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that every person being a Student in Medicine, Surgery or Pharmacy in this Province, who shall hereafter apply for a
