

to whom the law provides it shall be given, which, in this case, are the two sons of the deceased, provided they left no other children.

As both sons are minors, the first step will be for the Department to appoint a guardian or guardians for them and their property, into whose keeping the respective shares of the two sons would be given until they come of age; and until such guardians are appointed, you should see that none of the property is made away with by any party whatsoever.
