sir,-I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 4th instant, and in reply I beg to say that the Separate School Inspector stated that there was not sufficient blackboard space in the Mississans School and the Department agrees with him that one board of the dimensions mentioned by you should not meet the needs of the school, if the blackboard is resorted to as it should be. There is surely some space in the building in which additional blakeboards can be put up where they will be available for use. Findly look into this matter when you next visit the school.
