



With reference to your enquiry regarding the hunting and fishing privileges of the Mississaugas Indians of Almwick, I would like to point out that the Indians of Southern Ontario are practically on the same footing as Whites, in so far as hunting and fishing are concerned. They have no special privileges either on or off the Reserve, and are, in every way, subject to the game laws.
