now permited to fly for military purposes.

5. No immediate decision by Canada is required as a result of the President's proposals. The Interdepartmental Committee on International Civil Aviation has been set up to advise War Committee on Canada's post-war policy. It is now studying the pros and cons of alternative policies and will be presenting a comprehensive report in due course.
