The business before the meeting will be the consideration of the Annual Report, the election of Directors for the ensuing year, and to transact such other business as may be brought before the meeting.

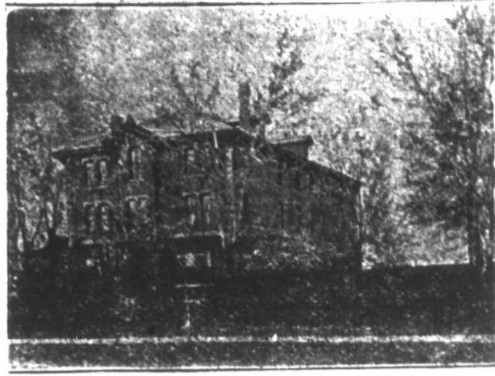
