Refolved. That previous to voting any money to any Colo-mel or Commanding Officer of Militia to reimburse him for the expence of Drums and Fifes provided under the eighth section of the act " For the better regulating the Militia in this Pro-" vince," there be produced to this House a certificate from the Captains or Commanding Officers of Companies (counterfigned by the Colonel or Commanding Officer of the Regiment) stating the several fines that have been imposed or collected by them from each delinquent by virtue of the said act; and also that no delinquent has been excused from paying his fine.

The committee appointed to manage the conference with the Report of a Council on the subject matter of the bill "For altering the " Sittings of the Supreme Court" further Reported, " That they " had again attended the faid conference, and that the Mana-" gers on the part of the Council faid the Council abide by " both of their former allegations, and they observed, that the " conference ought to be defired by that House where the bill " remains, and that they conceive the object of a conference " is to give reasons and not to inquire."

A message from the Council informing the House that the Message from Council request a conference on the subject matter of the bill now before the Council " For appropriating and disposing of "the Public Money"—and for that purpose have appointed a committee to meet a committee of the Assembly on Monday next.

Resolved,—That this House do agree to the said conference as defired by the Council.

Ordered, That Major Murray, Mr. Peters, and Mr. Wil- committee apliam Pagan be a committee to attend and manage the faid conference.

Ordered, That Mr. Glenie, Captain Agnew, and Major Members added Murray, be added to the committee appointed at the last session to a committee. on, to correspond with the Agent of the Province during the receis of the General Affembly.
