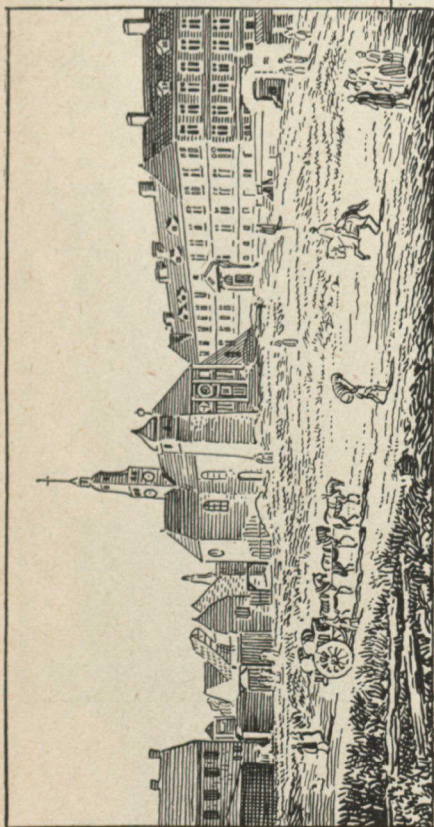
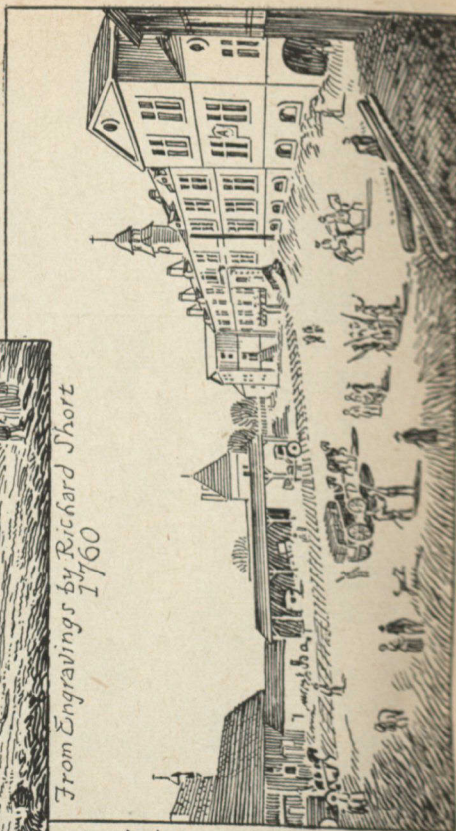




Intendant's Palace →
Quebec. On site of
brewery established by
Jafon. Became Intend-
ant's Residence 1689.
Twice destroyed by fire.
Above building erected
1726. Occupied by
American troops in
siege 1775-6, ruined in
bombardment. Today a
brewery again stands on
same site. Some of the
original vaults still
exist.

Jesuits' College
← Quebec
Built about 1744 on
site of present City
Hall. Was then the
finest building in
the City. Surrounded
by extensive grounds,
gardens & orchards.
Demolished 1878.
