## SURRENDERS HIS ARMY

Russian Governor of Sakhalin Island Gives Up Fight.

Gen. Liapoff, Seventy Officers and 3,200 Men Are Prisoners—Lack of Bandage Materials and Medicines Compelled Him From a Sense of Humanity to Terminate Hostilities—Japanese Terms Accepted.

Tokio, Aug. 5.—A report giving details of the final pursuit and surrender of the majority of the Russian garrison on Sakhalin Island has been received as follows: "An independent cavalry column on the afternoon of July 28 attacked the enemy south of Beilo and routed him, driving him southward, capturing two field guns, besides a number of rifles and a quantity of ammunition. "On July 29 the cavalry, being reinforced, vigorously pursued the enemy south of Taylan, which lies twenty miles south of Rykoff. The enemy halted at Onel, twenty-five miles south of Taylan, and at 5 o'clock on the morning of July 30 sent a letter under a flag of truce to the Japanese commanding officer from Gen. Liapoff, the Russian Governor, saying that the lack of bandage materials and medicines and the consequent inability to succor the wounded compelled him from a sense of humanity to terminate hostilities. "Jap Terms Accepted. "The commander of the Japanese force replied, demanding the delivery of all war supplies and property of the Russian Government, the unhurt, and the delivery of all maps, records and papers relating to the Russian civil and military administration, and requiring their delivery in reply at 10 o'clock on the morning of July 31, otherwise an attacking movement would immediately be started. "Col. Tolivich, on behalf of Governor Liapoff, met Col. Kozum, Japanese Chief of Staff, the morning of July 31, and accepted the proposed terms. "Governor Liapoff, 70 officers and 3,200 men of the Russian garrison then surrendered. "The spoils, consisting of clothing, papers and military supplies, are now under investigation. "A Big Battle Soon. "Tokio, Aug. 5.—It is reported that the advance guard of the hostile forces south of the Tumen River are within rifle range. An early conflict is regarded as inevitable. "Cruising Off Vladivostok. "Godoyadani, Aug. 5.—Despatches received from Korea report that the Japanese have begun a simultaneous advance from Kuan-chon against the Musaret and the Japanese advance detachments. The Russian losses, the despatches say were insignificant. Japanese warships were reported to be in the mouth of the Tumen River, on which Vladivostok is situated, their lights often being visible from Russian Island. "Chinese arriving from the south say that the Japanese most active in establishing trade relations in southern Manchuria, and that over a score of large business houses have been established at Yinkow and that 3,000 Japanese soldiers and traders follow close on the heels of the army. "Acts Like a Lunatic. "Buffalo, Aug. 5.—A man giving his name as Charles Howard, and his residence as Seaford, Ont., is under arrest at Niagara Falls, N. Y. He was acting in a peculiar manner, and was locked up for safety. He claimed that some one had squirted cold water on him while he was asleep, and the blood from his head had all run out of his body. He expected to die any moment, and he bid the police officer and Dr. Miller, who was called to examine him, farewell. A commission in lunacy will be appointed, and if through he will be taken to the Buffalo State Hospital.

**Premier Will Open Exhibition.**  
Toronto, Aug. 5.—Hon. J. P. Whitney, Premier of the Province of Ontario, has consented to open the exhibition on Tuesday, August 29. The ceremony will, as usual, take place in the theatre of the daily building, at 2 o'clock, after which the entire performance will be given in front of the grand stand, and in the evening the spectacle, The Fall of Port Arthur, will be presented.

**Literally Cooked Alive.**  
Marquette, Mich., Aug. 5.—Walter McCarthy, aged 15, was literally cooked alive in the seething mass of red-hot coals at the Carp River furnace. He was engaged in plastering the loading hole of a charcoal kiln to prevent the smoke from escaping through the opening. The fire department recovered the remains after the body had been badly burned.

**Homestead Entries.**  
Ottawa, Aug. 5.—The homestead entries for July show an increase of 701 over July, 1904. The entries for the past month were 3,729, against 3,019 for July last year. The largest increase was at Regina, where the number rose from 743 to 1,110. Battledore came next with 622, against 277 in July, 1904. The year promises to be a record breaker.

**Relief Ship Spoken.**  
Christiania, Norway, Aug. 5.—The Arctic vessel "Svea," which left on July 18 she spoke the Magdalene, the relief ship for the Zeigler Polar expedition in latitude 74 degrees 25 minutes north, longitude 10 degrees 23 minutes west. The Magdalene reported all well.

**Caught in Machinery.**  
Port Burwell, Aug. 5.—Night Watchman John McGraw, employed on the Government dredge here, was accidentally caught in the machinery shortly after it was started working yesterday morning and was so badly injured that he may not recover.

**Barn and Crops Burn.**  
Alvinston, Aug. 5.—Peter Duffy's barn, about three miles from here, was burned early yesterday morning. It contained over one hundred tons of hay, besides farming implements.
