COOKERY, FOR THE SICK.

Hints on How to Prepare Nutritious Food. A diet for the sick must usually comprise milk, oat, rice, gruel, crackers, or loaf prepared gruel, egg, beef, mutton, chicken, small game, oysters, fish, jellies, custards, and fruits.

It is well to keep food on hand that will not rot, and can be quickly brought in if he expresses a sudden desire to eat. BEEF JUICE.—Take a thick slice of round steak without fat, and broil it about two minutes, or until it is thoroughly heated, then cut into bits or mash it and press out the juice.

POACHED EGGS.—The best mode of serving cooked eggs for invalids. Break the egg into a white sauce, make into a round, flat cake, broil it over a hot fire until brown on the outside, dust with salt, and serve with a little cayenne pepper and hot butter, garnish with bits of butter.
