#### The World's Machines

In a great Palace of Engineering at the British Empire Exhibition, every machine known to the ingenuity of man has been collected and is shown under this monster roof.

It is an undoubted fact that machinery of any kind has an hypnotic attraction on the average person, and here the visitor has ample opportunity to study the complicated mechanism of every kind of machine. In one section there is an exhibit of the bridge, deck and upper works of a modern passenger steamer, and visitor can see the mechanism which controls the mass of machinery needed for driving the vessel, for supplying light, heat and ventilation, for operating lifts, pumps, capstans, davits, etc., for maintaining wireless communication with the shore, and for ensuring the comfort and safety of passengers. In these days, when the salvaging of vessels lost during the war is in operation in many parts of the world, the work of submarines divers is of special interest, and here are shown divers at work under water in a specially constructed lake equipped with the latest type of dress and helmet and telephone apparatus for communication with the salvage ship.

The Transport Section is thoroughly representative, the displays including full-sized express locomotive engines, passenger coaches, dining cars, and freight wagons of the very latest steel construction. The carriage of fruits, meats and perishable goods is fully illustrated by refrigerating wagons and plant.

With motor traction every day increasing its hold on the public ways of the world, it is not astonishing that a large section should be devoted to motor cars and other vehicles. The development of oil-burning for transport purposes is illustrated by Diesel engines, and visitors will appreciate how the oil in modern oil-burning ships is distributed from the tanks to the burners beneath the boilers. Side by side with these engines can be seen the latest development in steam turbines.

A specially interesting exhibit is the generating power station of the Exhibition in the Palace of Engineering.

mine in operation. Here in the depths of the ground are electric cutters at work, pumps running to keep the workings clear of water, fans for supplying fresh air, tubes filled with coal and drawn by pit ponies, while above ground is the complete headgear with winding apparatus for the cage, machines for washing and screening the coal, life-saving apparatus, medical appliances, bathrooms for the miners, etc.—in fact, a complete full-size reconstruction of a coal mine.

Every known kind of modern machinery used in the construction of concrete houses, the excavating and laying of concrete roads, are seen at work, whilst the pneumatic drills and rock drills driven on the new wave transmission system are shown in operation and will attract widespread interest. Side by side with these heavy apparatus is in everyday life the most delicate instruments known to human ingenuity and used chiefly in scientific research. Huge models of the latest aeroplanes and dirigible balloons fill another section, including the latest 1,500 h.p. aeroplane engine. In the Naval Section large models of battleships, cruisers, destroyers and submarines are to be seen. The largest individual piece of machinery in the Palace weighs 250 tons, and to transport into position this and other gigantic exhibits five large travelling cranes were installed in the building and are now exhibiting themselves.

There is not a single piece of machinery made in the British Empire which is not found in the Palace of Engineering.
