TRADE BOARDS INVITED TO TAX CONFERENCE
Montreal and Toronto Asked To Participate At Ottawa.
Winnipeg, Feb. 21.—On behalf of the Prairie Provinces, A. E. Parker, secretary of the Winnipeg board of trade, today wired the affiliated trade associations of Montreal and Toronto, inviting them to participate in a national tax reduction conference, planned to be held in Ottawa within the next two weeks.
Following the conference, it is expected that representations will be made to the Dominion Government by the combined boards of trade participating, asking for immediate remission or appeal of many existing taxes.

PASTOR EMMONS ATTRACTS MANY
