

SECOND DAY PROCEEDINGS OF THE PROVISIONAL BOARD.

The Provincial Board of Health held two sessions yesterday and will close their annual meeting to-day. It was announced that legislation had been enacted authorizing the formation of a provincial board of health for New Brunswick, which however, for want of an appropriation has not yet been accomplished.

A special committee appointed to examine the various bills introduced in relation to the duties of the board of health, reported that it was caused by the fact that 15,000 people being driven back by the water and this being made known to the board.
