THE ANGLICAN PORTUGUESE QUARREL.  
LONDON, Dec. 21.—The English quarrel with Portugal is becoming more acute. There are now direct charges against Major Serra Pinto, that he wanted to attack an African tribe in the Shire highlands which was under English protection. THE EMERGENCY WAS PRESENT.  
LONDON, Dec. 21.—The Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs, Mr. Balfour, has summoned the cabinet to consider Lord Salisbury's note calling upon Portugal to repudiate the acts of her agents on the Zambezi River and demanding the restoration of the status quo as it existed before the recent expedition of Serra Pinto. Owing to the urgency of the matter, Mr. Balfour's reply to the note, which will be amicable, will be telegraphed to London to-night.

THE ENGLISH STRIKERS.  
LONDON, Dec. 21.—The gas stokers in the South of London seem to be completely satisfied with the terms of the proposed agreement, and can no longer be said to exist. A certain number of old hands are out, and their places are filled by new hands. The supply of gas, which has never failed, is daily increasing, and all the works at the different stations of the company are at full operation. All of South London is lighted. The street lamps were dim for some days, but so serious difficulty has arisen anywhere in the district served by this single company. Coal is regularly unloaded at the company's wharves, Mr. Porter's Union proving thus far the most successful of the London coal companies.
