Mo smale Money Order, payable in the Dominion of Canada, can be issued at more than \$100, but as many of \$100 each may be given as the remitter source.

Money Orders are issued at this office payable in the following foreign matrix and British possessions:

## Registration.

Every letter and packet intended for registration must be banded in at the cket and a receipt obtained therefor. On no account must it be dropped on letter box. The registration fee must be pair by registration stamps, registration feet on letters to places in Canaon and Newfoundland is 2 its. to Great Britain and the United States, 5 cents.

The sender of a registered letter addressed to any Postal Union Country Beautic humself to a certificate as to the disposal of said letter by the Sunaster at the office addressed, on prepayment of an additional fee of 5c. Melasses of matter may be registered to Postal Union Countries.

### Parcel Post.

Parcels are sent to places within the Dominion of Canada conly) and should be plainly at ressed, marked "B. Parcel Post." The sender's name should be written on the lower left hand corner. A parcel must not contain a letter or any correspondence—postage 6 cents per 4 o.c. or fraction of 4 oz.; limit of weight, 5 lbs., within the Province. To the Eastern Provinces of the Dominion, the limit of weight is 2 lb. 3 oz. Parcels may be registered—fee 5c. The Parcel Post to Kootenay has been discontinued.
