Government, the renewal for another year of the Commercial modus vivendi concluded in Caracas on October 11, 1950*, which has governed the trade relations between Venezuela and Canada.

In reply, I am glad to let Your Excellency know that I have been

authorized by my Government to agree on the proposed renewal.

Therefore, and according to Your Excellency's suggestion, your Note together with this reply will be considered as an Agreement between both governments to nenew on the same terms the above modus vivendi as from the date of its expiry and until October 11, 1956.

I avail myself of this opportunity to renew to Your Excellency the

assurances of my highest and distinguished consideration.
