STATEMENT BY MR. SPEAKER

MR. SPEAKER: In view of the announcement in the House on Saturday last by the Right Honourable Prime Minister that Her Most Gracious Majesty the Queen had designated His Royal Highness Prince Charles as Prince of Wales, it would be appropriate to amend the wording of the Prayer for the Royal Family to reflect the change in the title to the Heir Apparent.

May I have the approval of the House to the appropriate change, which I took the liberty of making when reading the Prayers today?

The House having consented to the proposed change:

The Prayer for the Royal Family will be as follows:

ALMIGHTY GOD, the fountain of all goodness, we humbly beseech thee to bless Elizabeth the Queen Mother, the Prince Philip, Duke of Edinburgh, Charles Prince of Wales, and all the Royal Family: Endue them with thy Holy Spirit; enrich them with thy heavenly grace; prosper them with all happiness; and bring them to thine everlasting kingdom; through Jesus Christ our Lord—Amen.

Mr. Fleming (Eglinton), a Member of the Queen's Privy Council, laid before the House,—Copy of proposed amendments to the Budget Resolutions (Excise Tax Act and Customs Tariff).
