

PRAYERS.

The following petition was presented:—

By the Honourable the Chairman of the Committee on Divorce:—

Of Maurice Amédée Tremblay, of Montreal, Quebec, bond salesman; praying for the passage of an Act to annul his marriage with Jeanne Rénée de Sales La Terrière Tremblay.

The Honourable Senator Black, from the Standing Committee on Banking and Commerce, to whom was referred the Bill (A), intituled: "An Act to enable the establishment, operation and maintenance of free foreign trade zones," reported that they had gone through the said Bill, and had directed him to report the same to the Senate, without any amendment.

With leave of the Senate,

The said Bill was then read the third time.

The question was put whether this Bill shall pass.

It was resolved in the affirmative.

Ordered, That the Clerk do go down to the House of Commons and acquaint that House that the Senate have passed this Bill, to which they desire their concurrence.

The Honourable Senator Black, from the Standing Committee on Banking and Commerce, to whom was referred the Bill (D), intituled: "An Act to incorporate Federal Fire Insurance Company of Canada," reported that they had gone through the said Bill, and had directed him to report the same to the Senate, without any amendment.

Ordered, That the said Bill be placed on the Orders of the Day for a third reading at the next sitting of the Senate.

The Honourable Senator Black, from the Standing Committee on Banking and Commerce, to whom was referred the Bill (E), intituled: "An Act to incorporate Wellington Fire Insurance Company," reported that they had gone through the said Bill, and had directed him to report the same to the Senate, without any amendment.

Ordered, That the said Bill be placed on the Orders of the Day for a third reading at the next sitting of the Senate.

The Honourable Senator Black, from the Standing Committee on Banking and Commerce, to whom was referred the Bill (U), intituled: "An Act to incorporate the Sons of Scotland Benevolent Association," reported that they had gone through the said Bill, and had directed him to report the same to the Senate with several amendments which he was ready to submit whenever the Senate would be pleased to receive the same.

The said amendments were then read by the Clerk, as follows:—

1. Page 2, line 34. For the word "premium" substitute the word "premiums".

2. Page 3, line 15. After the word "years." insert the words "or as may be approved by the Superintendent of Insurance."

3. Page 3, line 37. For the word "the" substitute the word "its".

4. Page 3, lines 38 to 46, inclusive. Leave out all the words to the end of the subsection.

The said amendments were concurred in, and—

Ordered, That the said Bill be placed on the Orders of the Day for a third reading at the next sitting of the Senate.
