ARTICLE I.

ARTICLE II.

The Trustees shall call a general meeting of the congregation requirements, annually, to be held on the twenty-fifth day of December—or shoul ongregation; ent the person that day fall on a Sabbath, then on the following day, -notice the name of th which must be given from the precentor's desk on the two preceding Sabbaths; at which meeting the Trustees shall lay before the congression a statement of all gation a statement of all accounts and financial matters connected with the December of the congression, shall the church and congregation.
