nius would here be wanting, with his celeftial Fire. But happily it is already infpired. The Fire of Valour already burns and flames in every Part. The important Interefts my brave Countrymen are espousing, and the noble. Motives they have to act with Steadiness and Intrepidity, have long fince roused their Attention, and spirited them up to an uncommon Pitch of martial and heroick Ardor. To remind them of these, and thereby augment the generous Heat, and blow it up to a fiercer Flame, is all that needs to be done.

You well know, Gentlemen, and doubtless glory in the Thought, that you are rifing up in Defence of a great and excellent People; a People every way worthy of your Friendship and Protection; your Love, your Admiration,
