The exports from Scotland to America and the Weft Indies, we know are confiderable. Could I have procured them, they would have been inferted; however, there can be no doubt. that, when added, they will increase the value of the exports to the Plantations from Great Britain, to upwards £ 6,000,000 0 0 of which is nearly equal to the amount of all the foreign exports of this kingdom, and to one-half of the whole famiga commerce of the nation, exclusive only, of that to Ireland and the East Indies.

From the preceding facts and remarks, the advocates for American Independence may perceive, that what they contend for, is nothing lefs than to difmember, from the British community, the greatest part of its territory, and more than one fourth part of its people, and to give up near one balf of its commerce (the trade to Ireland and the East Indies excepted), foreign as well as Colonial;
