DENTIST COOK DROWNED.

He Went in Bathing Off Mimico and Lost His Life—His Career.

Dr. George H. Cook, the well-known dentist of the West End, was drowned on Saturday afternoon, while bathing in the lake off Mimico Beach. There were half a dozen people in the water at the time, but all efforts to save him proved fruitless. Deceased had been in the city at his office during the morning and part of the afternoon. He had promised to return at an early hour, but was delayed.

Went in to Bathe.
Arriving at his summer home about 4.30, he saw his wife and several others of the residents in bathing. He hurried to a boat house where he stored his bicycle and hastily donned his bathing suit. Not waiting to take a rest after his first ride on his bicycle, he ran down the embankment to the beach and jumped into the water. The water at that point is about five feet deep, but as Mr. Cook was a man about six feet high, he evidently thought of no danger.

Carried into Deep Water.
No sooner had he reached the water than a large roller caught him and carried him down. A strong southeast wind, which was blowing at the time, caused a heavy undercurrent, and it is thought Dr. Cook was carried out for some distance.

Once a student, who was also in the water at the time, heard Dr. Cook cry out once for help and he tried to assist him. The big wave prevented him getting within reach of deceased, so he went to land. Others on the beach had manned a rowboat in the meantime and put out to rescue the doctor. It was about five minutes before the boat reached the water, but as the water was so rough and the waves so heavy that they could not get back on the beach.

Found 25 Minutes Later.
About 25 minutes after the doctor had jumped in his body was washed ashore by the waves.

Dr. Geoffrey of Mimico was soon on the scene and he worked for over an hour on the body without success. The remains were afterwards brought to Toronto on the evening train and conveyed to Alex. Millard's undertaking establishment. The late Dr. Cook, with his family, had been residing at Mimico all summer. He was to his cottage lives Mr. Stover of the Elgin Rogers Company. The late doctor had many friends on the beach, and it is thought he was very popular.

Were the Articles Stolen?

The remains were noted and later in the day William Gammage, a mechanic, and Walter Langdon, 122 Mechanic's place, were taken into custody by Detective Venn. They are both charged with stealing the missing clothes.
